



The Foundation of the Queensland **Gas Association (QGA)**

The QGA was first established back in the year 2000 due to the need for gas approval certification of non-mass production gas appliances in Queensland. The QGA was first driven by the commercial cooking industry initially, and since then has evolved to include other Type A gas devices including caravan and marine gas devices. The association facilitates gas approval applications for Type A gas devices in Queensland. We assist and carry out gas approvals for individual Type A gas devices to ensure the safety of gasfitters and end users. A number of our association committee members are approval authorities and can carry out gas approval certification. The QGA has assisted with the process of safety testing/certification of over 15,000 Type A gas devices in Queensland over the years.

Over time the QGA became a membership-based association also and is run by professionals for professionals within the gas industry. The committee is made up of four executives and also has a number of its members which form the members' committee.

All are unpaid volunteers who commit their expertise for the success of our industry. We believe our partners and QGA members are the most important people when it comes to the success and continued growth of the Queensland Gas Association.

The association has established a reputation for delivering well-informed development technical sessions, interesting field trips, along with providing technical advice from our range of member specialists. The QGA have and will always be an advocate for the gas industry as a whole.
